INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) Refer to the Stock Availability spreadsheet on the GrainCorp website. Grain will either be "available", "not available", or "available by arrangement".
- (2) Contact the relevant Road Logistics Co-ordinator (contact details are on the Stock Availability spreadsheet). **Note that no outturn can take place unless the GSO has been faxed/emailed to the Logistics Department.**
- (3) Road orders are valid for a maximum of one week period, with the week commencing on Monday.
- (4) Planned outload days and tones per day **MUST** be nominated.
- (5) Manned sites – orders must be received by 3pm on the working day prior to the planned outturn date. Unmanned sites – orders must be received by 3pm 2 working days prior to the planned outturn date.
- (6) All outloading, weekend working, outloading fees and restrictions etc, shall apply as per the Storage and Handling Agreement
